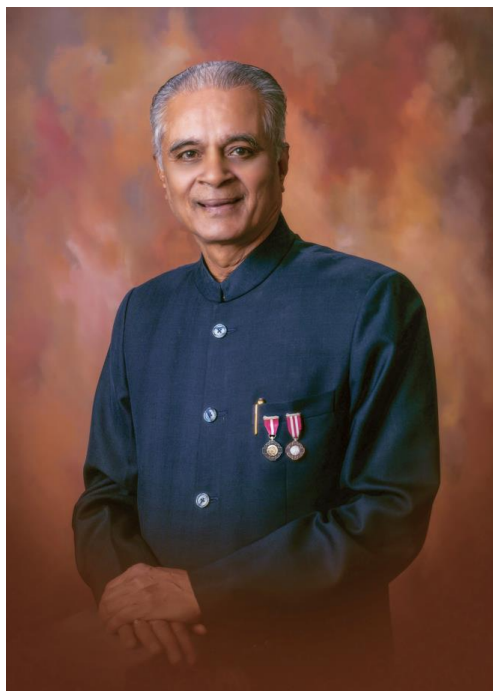

SLAT Test Registration

A. SLAT test registration process

SLAT Test 2027 will be conducted on two different dates. Please note these dates carefully:

SLAT Test	Date
SLAT 01	December 19,2026 (Saturday)
SLAT 02	December 26,2026 (Saturday)

Timings of the tests will be communicated to the candidates via their Admit Card

A candidate can appear for upto two tests for SLAT 2027. If a candidate appears for more than one test, the higher score will be considered for the final percentile calculation. There will be no normalization. A rigorous process that has been statistically tested will be administered to ensure that unique types of questions are framed under a specific topic across the question papers. The normal spread will ensure that there is no unfair advantage to candidates who opt for any specific test / multiple tests. This will ensure the normalisation of the spread of questions across sections. Furthermore, the question papers will be normalised for the level of difficulty across all two tests. No correspondence regarding this will be entertained.

The registration process is as follows:

1. Register & Verify Your Account

- Check that the SLAT application window is open before starting.
- Keep your email, WhatsApp-enabled mobile number and passport-style photo ready.
- Enter your name, email, country code and mobile number.
- Accept the mandatory consent for registration and admission updates.
- Verify the OTP sent to your email and WhatsApp. If the OTP does not arrive, wait 60 seconds and use Resend OTP.
- Use the same email and mobile number throughout the admission process.

2. Complete Basic Details & Upload Photo

- Enter your name, DOB, nationality, NRI status, state and admission category.
- Ensure your name and DOB match your SSC/HSC certificate exactly.
- Upload a recent passport-style photograph.
- Your photo should show one clear, front-facing and fully visible face.
- Avoid blurred, cropped, side-facing, group or obstructed photos.
- PwD/category candidates must provide the additional details applicable to them.
- Save and continue after all required fields pass validation.

3. Select Test Dates, Cities & Pay Test Fee

- Select the SLAT test date(s) you want to appear for.
- The test fee is ₹2,550 per selected test date.
- For each test, select 3 different city preferences in order.
- Review your test dates and city preferences before making payment.
- Pay online by card, UPI or net banking, or use the available DD option.
- Do not refresh or close the browser while payment is processing.
- Save your transaction ID and payment receipt after successful payment.

4. Complete Personal, Academic & Programme Details

- Enter your personal details, address, contact information and other required fields.
- Add SSC/Class 10 and HSC/Class 12 educational details.
- Upload applicable documents such as category/caste or PwD certificates.
- Select the institutes and programmes you wish to apply to.
- Some programmes may require additional information after selection.

- Programme fee is ₹1,000 for each programme selected.
- Remember: paying only the test fee does not make you eligible for programme consideration.

5. Pay Programme Fee, Review & Submit

- Review your name, DOB, category, test dates, cities and selected programmes carefully.
 - Pay ₹1,000 × number of programmes selected.
 - Wait for the payment confirmation before leaving the page.
 - After successful payment, your programme application is submitted.
 - Download/print your completed application and keep all receipts safely.
 - For permitted corrections or assistance, use Raise Query from the dashboard.
 - Both the test fee and applicable programme fee must be paid for your application to be considered.
6. After successful registration, you will get an e-mail and SMS containing your SLAT ID and password. Use this SLAT ID for all communications regarding the SLAT 2027 entrance test / admission procedure.
7. Pay the SLAT entrance test registration fee of **INR 2550 per test** [government taxes would be additional as and when applicable] non-transferable and non-refundable as per the instructions mentioned on the Registration Portal.
8. In addition to that, you are also expected to pay the non-refundable and non-transferable programme registration fee of **INR 1000/- for each programme**(government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) that you wish to apply for.
- 9. Please note that payment of only the SLAT entrance test registration fee will not make you eligible for shortlisting in any programme, regardless of your SLAT score. Both fees must be paid as per the instructions provided on the registration portal. - 15.A candidate can appear for SLAT on both the dates December 19,2026 (Saturday) and December 26,2026 (Saturday). If a candidate appears for more than one test, the higher score will be considered for the final percentile calculation.**
- 16.Please also note that if any information provided by a candidate is found to be incorrect, the University shall have right to cancel the candidature of that candidate.

E. Programme registration fee payment process

A candidate desirous to submit his candidature to select UG programmes, is also required to complete the payment process of desired programme before the closing date of payment of the same. Payment towards the programmes must be made through the website only (www.slat-test.org). After making the payment for **SLAT**, proceed to complete the online registration form (Part II) for Programme (s) registration and the respective institute(s). A candidate is required to make separate **non-refundable** and **non-transferable** payment of **INR 1000/-** (government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) **per programme per institute at this stage**.

If candidates want to pay programme payment through Demand Draft, make Demand Draft of INR 1000/- (government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) for **each programme** in the name of “**Symbiosis Test Secretariat**”.

Even after closing of the payment for SLAT 2027, a candidate may still pay through website till the last date of payment for the programme(s). An institute may offer more than one programme. A candidate should ensure that the preferred programme(s) is / are selected and paid before the last date.

Indian nationals and NRI candidates shall have to apply under SLAT 2027 to seek admission to the select Undergraduate programmes of Symbiosis International (Deemed University).

After the declaration of the SLAT 2027 result, the institute (offering the programme(s) for which you have paid) will conduct further admission processes for short-listed candidates. The schedule for the same will be published on the website of the respective institute(s).

Process to be followed for Persons with Disabilities (PwD):

- The candidate applying for the entrance tests/admission in the Persons with Disabilities (PwD), selects the type of disability available in the PwD options on the portal.
- A Persons with Disabilities (PwD) candidate is required to upload his/her copy of Disability Certificate issued by Competent Government Medical Authority the and Unique Disability ID (UD ID) Card at the time of registration for entrance/admission of SIU to ascertain percentage and the type of the disability.
- The Medical Superintendent, SUHRC through Medical Board shall ascertain the genuineness of the said documents. Once the documents are found authentic and correct by the Medical Board, SUHRC, his/her eligibility will be certified under the PwD category.

Note - If a candidate selects a Persons with Disabilities (PwD) in the Registration form and s/he requires scribe/writer facility please note SIU will not be providing scribe/writer. The candidate has to make her/his own arrangement for scribe/writer. The qualification of scribe/writer should be a maximum 9th standard candidate or a maximum 9th standard passed candidate (Or Appearing 10th Standard). The scribe should not have completed studies beyond the 9th standard. Candidate should send the request to info@slat-test.org , on or **before December 04,2026 (Friday)** in case scribe/writer is required.

As per SIU norms, a Persons with Disabilities (PwD) is provided with 20 minutes of compensatory time for every 60 minutes of test.

A candidate applying under any of the reserved category (Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes/ Person with Disabilities (PwD)/ Kashmiri Migrants/ Children/wards of Defence Personnel) are mandatorily required to upload and submit relevant document issued by competent authority. Any participation at any stage of admission process by such candidate is purely provisional and always subject to verification and authentication of such relevant document.
2. I. Reservation of seats for Nagpur Domicile (SLS, Nagpur)

Reservation of seats for Nagpur Domicile (SLS, Nagpur) (25% of seats within the sanctioned intake- Only in case of Constituents at Off-Campus center, Nagpur)

In accordance with Clause A of Schedule C of the Lease Deed signed between Nagpur Municipal Corporation, Nagpur and Symbiosis, Pune on 4th September, 2017, the University has reserved 25% seats against the approved intake in each programme offered at the Off-campus Centre of the University at Nagpur for Nagpur Domiciled candidates.

The definition for Nagpur Domicile is:

Nagpur Domiciled' means candidates, who are domiciled in Nagpur for a period of 5(five) years as on the date of commencement of the academic year and who (a) are or will be graduates or students of Nagpur University, **and/ or** (b) are recipients of school certificates from the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, the Council of Indian School Certificate Examinations, and/ or the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)/ ICSE Board.

While giving admission under the Nagpur domicile category-

- **Residence Criterion:** Resident of Nagpur Urban (five continuous or intermittent years) is mandatory,
- **Educational Criterion:** The candidate should fulfil one of the following criteria

(a) graduate or pursuing graduation from Nagpur University

- OR-

(b) school certificates (10th and 12th) from (i) Maharashtra Board, (ii) CISCE (iii) CBSE, (iv) ICSE (***It simply means 10th and 12th passed certificates from other State Boards and foreign school boards are NOT accepted***)

J. International Candidates admission process

The Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE)

Admissions of international students are centralized for all the constituent institutes of Symbiosis International Deemed University and are routed through the Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE).

SCIE earmarks a 25% Over and Above Intake of the total intake of the respective programme for international students which include, Foreign Nationals (FN), Person of Indian Origin (PIO) Card Holders, Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) Card Holders, and Non-Resident Indians (NRI).

Foreign National (FN):

A student is eligible to apply as a Foreign National (FN) if he/she is a citizen of any country other than India and holds a foreign passport.

Overseas Citizen of India (OCI):

A student is eligible to apply as OCI if he/she is granted with Overseas Citizenship of India and has an OCI card.

Person of Indian Origin (PIO):

As per the Government of India notification dated 9th January 2015, all the existing Persons of Indian Origin cardholders registered as such shall be deemed to be Overseas Citizens of India cardholders.

[As per the Government of India Notification dated 9th January 2015, the existing Persons of Indian Origin card holder registered as such shall be deemed to be Overseas Citizens of India card holders (OCI).]

Non-Resident Indian (NRI):

A candidate is eligible to apply as a Non-Resident Indian (NRI) if she/he is an Indian National and has appeared for the 12th examination (equivalent to the Indian 12th) or graduation outside India. It is mandatory for one of the two qualifying examinations to be taken outside India.

NRI applying under International category entrance exam is not mandatory

OCI/ PIO/ Foreign Nationals are exempted from appearing for SLAT 2027 and have to apply through Symbiosis Centre for International Education (www.scie.ac.in).

3. Admit Card along with **Original** Photo Identity proof should be carried to the Test Centre at the time of the test.

An acceptable photo identity is any one of the following:

Note: Soft copy of identity proof will not be accepted.

4. An authorized person will verify and authenticate your Admit Card against the photo-id on the day of the test. Please preserve this authenticated Admit Card for further PI processes.

5. Candidates should note that an authenticated Admit Card is an important document without which the candidate will not be permitted to appear for further admission processes of SIU. If the Authenticated Admit card is lost, **a duplicate Authenticated Admit Card will not be issued.** It should be retained till the admission process is over.

6. Cell phones, calculators, watch calculators, alarm clocks, digital watches with built-in calculators/memory, or any electronic gadgets—including smart devices such as smartwatches, fitness bands, Meta Glass, or similar wearable technology—will not be allowed in the test hall.
